MOTION by Munro, supported by Sovel, to amend the Sewer Ordinance and Fee Ordinance be to permit customers not on a public water system to select one of two alternatives for assessing capital charges: the standard REU approach that has been used historically or the determination of appropriate meter size using the American Water Works Association (AWWA M22: Sizing Water Service Lines and Meters) approach.

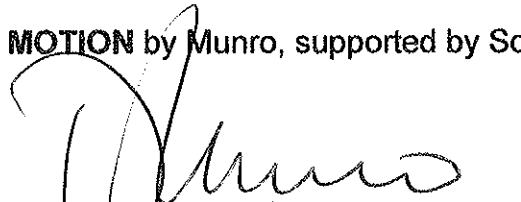

WHEREAS, the improvement associated with the Fox Lake Weed Control Special Assessment District has expired, and;

WHEREAS, the remaining Twenty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars and 32 cents (\$24,263.32) in surplus funds in the Special Assessment District following payment of all expenses related to the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Board of the Charter Township of Commerce that the sum of Twenty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars and 32 cents (**\$24,263.32**), representing the balance, less costs associated with the refund, shall be refunded on a prorated basis to the owners of properties assessed in the Fox Lake Weed Control Special Assessment District. Payment shall be made to owners of the property as of the date of this Resolution.

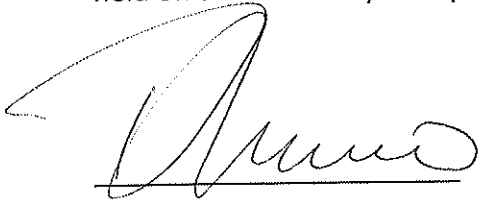
