Library Director Lobert -

Head of Information Services Trista Reno has prepared a draft substitute librarian job description for your review.

While Commerce Township Community Library has budgeted for a substitute librarian position in 2024, we do not have an approved job description. Trista and I envision utilizing the substitute librarians to help cover planned and unplanned staff absences for illness, family leave, vacation, and continuing education. Substitute librarians will also be scheduled to work select Sundays, where scheduled events indicate that staff would benefit from additional manpower.

This job description has been reviewed by Commerce Township's Finance/Human Resources Director Katelyn Massey and, upon your approval, would be presented to the Township Board of Trustees for consideration.
