The following preamble and resolution were offered by Gross and supported by Munro.

WHEREAS, the improvement associated with the Ladd Sanitary Sewer Special Assessment District has been completed and the bonds sold in connection therewith have been paid, and;

WHEREAS, there remaining One Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Sixty-One Dollars and 37 cents (\$159061.37) in surplus funds in the Special Assessment District following payment of bonds and all expenses related to the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Board of the Charter Township of Commerce that the sum of One Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand, Sixty-One Dollars and 37 cents (\$159,061.37), representing the balance, less costs associated with the refund, **shall be refunded on a prorated basis to the owners of properties assessed in the Ladd Sanitary Sewer Special Assessment Districts.** Payment shall be made to owners of the property as of the date of this Resolution.

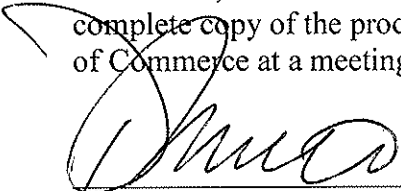
